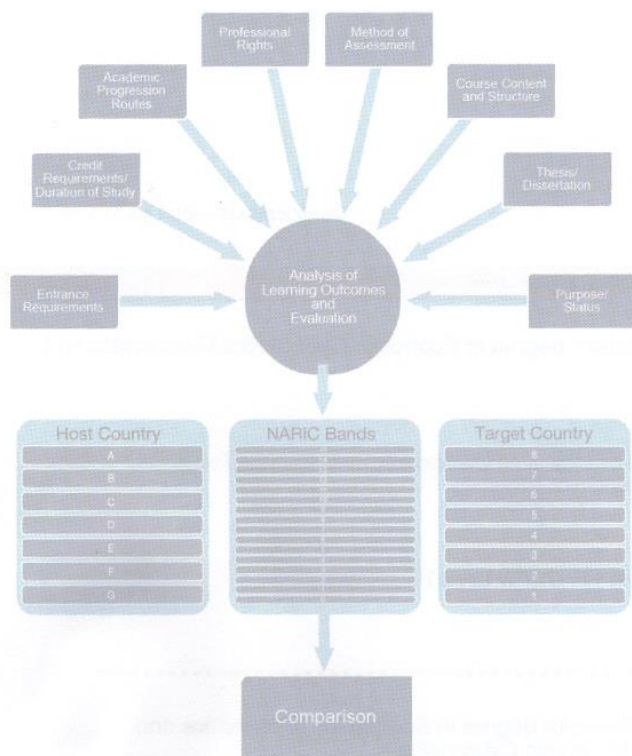

How qualifications are evaluated and compared



The United Kingdom is a signatory to the Convention on the Recognition of Qualifications concerning Higher Education in the European Region, 1997; UK NARIC is the UK's national qualification information centre. The Convention sets out the broad guidelines by which international qualifications are recognised in a signatory country.

UK NARIC has further developed its evaluation system, so that the Statement of Comparability can fully reflect the range and type of qualifications received from across the world.

The UK NARIC Band Framework® allows for a formal qualification at any level of any education system to be mapped across to a comparable level within the education systems and frameworks operating across the UK. This process is guided by the principles of the Convention; it is objective, fair, and rigorous.

The above diagram gives an overview of UK NARIC's evaluation process. There are 16 hierarchical, learning outcome-based Bands, which are independent of the nominal distinctions between secondary, undergraduate and postgraduate cycles of study. Significant differences exist between national education systems, so it is not, for instance, automatically the case that a Bachelor degree in one country will compare directly to a Bachelor degree in the UK.

This analysis is separate from any consideration of the grades or marks achieved by an individual. A higher grade in an examination assessing a lower level learning outcome does not necessarily mean a higher level outcome is being achieved. To give a full picture to an employer or institution, you should present a range of evidence, including your transcripts that show your marks and grades, module-by-module.

The comparability information is shown; each Certificate features one qualification in a centred display format. For details, log in to the UK NARIC application portal and choose Additional Services.

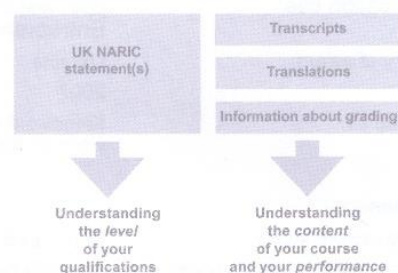
Showcase your skills

To give a full picture of your achievement, qualifications, knowledge, expertise, skills, and experience, do not rely on only your UK NARIC statement.

Present a full range of evidence to the employer or institution so that they can fully understand your qualifications, achievement, and skills:

- Qualification final certificates
- Transcripts with modules and grades
- Your UK NARIC statement(s)
- CV featuring experience, skills, attributes
- Portfolio of work, if appropriate

Remember to include translations of your certificates and transcripts, if necessary.
